

Thank you for your interest in Eastern Michigan University's School of Nursing second degree BSN program sequence. Listed below are the steps you must follow to be considered:

1. Apply for admission as a second bachelor student: in person, 401 Pierce Hall, Ypsilanti, MI 48197 or online at: www.emich.edu/admissions/apply/. The phone number for Admissions is 800.GO.TO.EMU. Admission to EMU does not mean that you are admitted into the School of Nursing.
2. After you have been accepted as an EMU second bachelor student, call the Second Bachelor Program office at 734.487.5497 to schedule an appointment. We are located in the Academic Advising Center, 301 Pierce Hall. During the appointment your transcripts will be reviewed and you will be given an unofficial program of study showing how your previously completed credits will satisfy the prerequisite program requirements for the School of Nursing.
3. Admission to the School of Nursing second degree BSN program sequence is very competitive. The deadline for this application is **May 15, 2008**. The application is available at: www.emich.edu/nursing/. All prerequisites must be completed to apply to the School of Nursing. The prerequisites are: ENGL 121 English Composition II, general education Math class or waiver, CHEM 120 Fundamentals of Organic and Biochemistry, PSY 101 or PSY 102 General Psychology, ZOOL 201 **and** 202 **or** SPMD 201 **and** 202 Human Anatomy and Physiology I and II, ANTH 135 Introduction to Cultural Anthropology **or** SOCL 105 Introduction to Sociology and IHHS 260 Aging to Infancy: a Life Course Retrospective **or** EDPS 325 Life Span Human Growth and Development. No course can be less than a "C" and the grade point average (GPA) of the eight (8) prerequisite classes must be at least a 3.0 (on a 4.0 scale) to be able to apply.
