Items to Bring: Two forms of picture identification (student ID is appropriate for EMU students only)
Check or credit card details (separate check of \$10 is required for essay)
CLEP Test Center Admission Form (confirmation sent on receipt of your registration)
Non-mechanical pencil

Items not Allowed: food, drink, books, papers, calculators, cellular phones, beepers or PDAs

Length of Exam: 90 minutes without essay
180 minutes with essay

Exam Results (no essay): you will receive your score immediately after the exam

Exam Results with Essay: your final score is calculated by averaging the two individual scores which can take four to six weeks after the exam date

Earning Credit: you will receive a letter in the mail indicating whether or not you are receiving course credits for the exam

Retaking Exams: you must wait six months to retake the same CLEP exam

Other Test Locations: other colleges and universities may offer different dates and times, indicate EMU as the place you wish your scores to be sent (contact the CLEP Administrator for exams requiring the essay for EMU credit)
