***Program fee includes:***

- All rail and bus transportation between cities.
- Field trips and excursions by train, chartered bus, or boat.
- Tickets to all cultural events arranged by the program.
- Entrance tickets to museums visited by the program.

- Couchettes when possible on overnight trains.
- Hotel service charges and local taxes.
- International Student ID Card (EMU students)
- Health insurance (EMU students)

***Program fee does not include:***

- Tuition for 6 undergraduate semester hours.\*
- Air transportation from the U.S. to Shanghai and return from Beijing. The Program will provide a compulsory flight package from the West Coast to China and return which each student must purchase.
- Most Meals or beverages
- Street car, bus or subway fares within cities to cultural events, museums, sites, etc.
- Passports, textbooks, laundry, independent travel and expenses of a purely personal nature.
