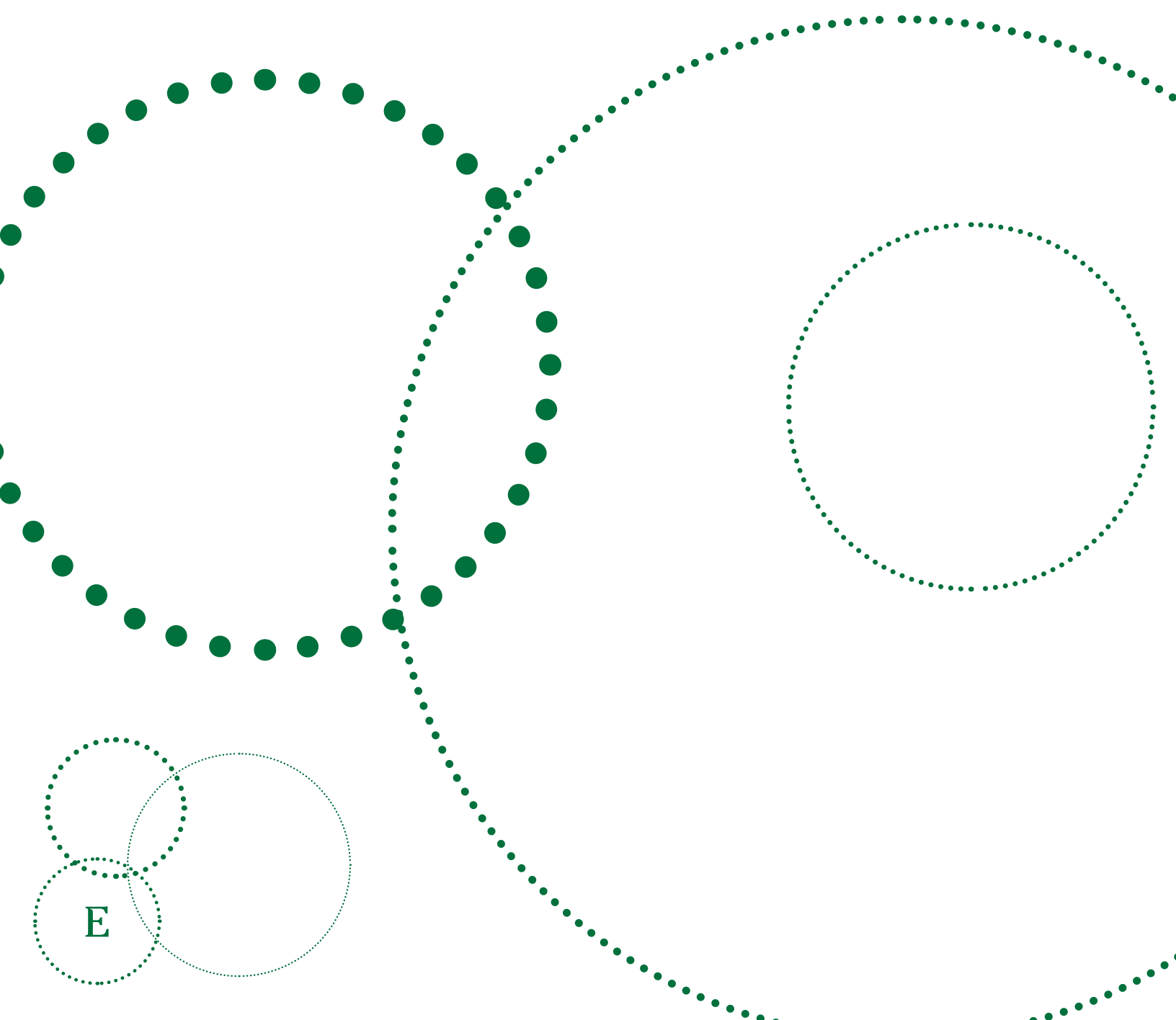

How to apply to EMU

EMU uses a rolling admission process. Typically, we notify students of their admission decision within 2-4 weeks of receiving all required application materials. Carefully complete the application form on the facing page and enclose the non-refundable \$30 processing fee (\$20 online). Follow the directions below to complete your application process. To apply online, visit emich.edu/admissions/apply.

Information for freshmen

The primary criteria for admission to EMU as a freshman are:

- High School GPA or GED scores
- ACT/SAT test scores*
- High school curriculum
- Academic and personal honors

When you apply for admission as a freshmen:

- You must request that an official transcript be sent to EMU in a sealed envelope from your high school. GED scores may be used in place of a high school transcript.
- You must request that official ACT or SAT scores be sent to EMU.* Check with your high school to see if official scores are included with your transcript, or visit actstudent.org (ACT) or collegeboard.com (SAT) to have official scores sent to EMU. EMU's ACT test code is 1990 and SAT test code is 1220.
- You will receive an admission decision by mail and you will automatically receive consideration for academic scholarships.

*Freshman applicants who are 21 or older are not required to submit test scores.

Information for transfer students

If you have enrolled at a community college or other college or university after graduating high school, and do not yet have a bachelor's degree, we will review your application as a transfer student. **The minimum requirements for admission to EMU as a transfer student are a 2.0 cumulative college GPA and 12 transferrable credits.** To determine whether you meet the requirements for admission as a transfer student, visit emich.edu/admissions or call Transfer Services at 734-487-1442.

When you apply for admission as a transfer student:

- **You must request that an official transcript be sent to EMU in a sealed envelope from every college or university you have attended.**
- You will receive an admission decision by mail and, if applicable, an evaluation of transfer credit showing which courses you've completed and how they will transfer to EMU.

- Transfer course equivalency and evaluation of credit.
- Articulation agreements and transfer guides for community colleges.
- EMU's general education requirements and specific program requirements.
