

# What is Fast Track Orientation?



Fast Track Orientation is the mandatory enrollment program for admitted high school seniors who are planning to attend EMU in the fall. **Signing up for Fast Track Orientation this spring is the most important next step for you to take if you've decided to attend EMU!** At Fast Track Orientation, you'll register for fall classes and have your picture taken for your EMU student ID. Your parents will learn details on EMU's financial aid, housing, billing, campus safety initiatives, and more. In short, Fast Track Orientation is designed to

take care of all of the "business" needs of becoming an EMU student in one day.

**The earlier you attend Fast Track Orientation, the better your chances will be for getting the classes and class times that you want for the fall.**

## Am I required to attend Fast Track Orientation?

All students who plan to attend EMU in the fall must attend Fast Track Orientation this spring. If you live too far from EMU's campus to attend in person, call 800.GO.TO.EMU, and we'll gladly set up an alternate way for you to participate.

## During Fast Track Orientation, you will:

- Learn about general education classes that every EMU student takes
  - Meet with faculty and staff to pick classes for your individual major
  - Register for fall classes
  - Learn about the benefits of residence hall living
  - Have your photo taken for your EMU student ID card
  - Meet with financial aid, academic support staff, and more campus offices
  - Learn about Fusion Orientation
- In addition, you can:
- Pre-order college textbooks
  - See a residence hall room

## How long is the program?

On the day you choose to attend, check-in starts at 8 a.m. The program begins promptly at 8:30 and ends by 2:30 p.m.

## Should parents/family attend?

Yes! We have a special program for parents and family to learn more about financial, business, academic and community support resources.

## What do I need to bring to Fast Track Orientation?

- A government-issued photo ID
- Fast Track Orientation checklist (you'll receive this in advance by mail or email)
- Any financial aid award and scholarship paperwork that you have received from EMU. Financial aid and scholarship staff will be at Fast Track Orientation to answer questions.
- Wear comfortable, weather-appropriate clothing, including shoes that are good for walking.

## What is the cost?

The cost is \$29 per student. The Fast Track Orientation fee is automatically billed to every incoming student's fall bill and covers materials for the program. **The fee is collected in September. No payment is required on the day of Fast Track Orientation.**

## Where do I go?

Fast Track Orientation is held at the EMU Student Center. You'll receive a map and driving directions by mail once you sign up for Fast Track Orientation. You can also find directions to the Student Center at [emich.edu/go](http://emich.edu/go)

## How do I sign up for housing?

Visit [emich.edu/housing](http://emich.edu/housing) to review your residence hall options and submit a housing contract online. Pay the \$200 housing pre-payment to reserve your space in the residence halls. We recommend completing your housing contract prior to May 1, 2009, but you may attend Fast Track Orientation even if you have not yet completed a housing contract.

## How do I set up a my.emich account?

If you haven't already, visit [my.emich.edu](http://my.emich.edu) to set up an account and access all of EMU's web resources. To set up an account, have your student number and PIN ready (get these numbers from your admission letter or by calling 800.GO.TO.EMU), and click on "How do I get my username and password."

## Choosing a date

If you're committed to one specific major, choose a date for that major grouping so that you can get the best guidance from faculty and advisers in your major. If you're not committed to one specific major, choose a date that fits well with your schedule and your possible academic interests. Call 800.GO.TO.EMU today to sign up for Fast Track Orientation.
