

FAST FAQs:

Am I required to attend both Fast Track and First Four?

Yes, attending both Fast Track and First Four is vital to ensuring your successful transition to EMU. If you live too far from campus to attend Fast Track in person, call 800.GO.TO.EMU and we'll gladly set up an alternate way for you to participate.

Should parents/family attend?

Yes! Our family programs provide valuable information regarding financial, business, academic and community support resources. We also offer guidance to help prepare for the transition to college, including changing relationships, family expectations, and student development during the college years.

What do I need to bring to Fusion New Student Orientation?

1. A government-issued photo ID.
2. Fast Track checklist (you'll receive this in advance by mail or email).
3. Any financial aid award and scholarship paperwork received from EMU. Financial aid and scholarship staff will be available.
4. Wear comfortable, weather-appropriate clothing, including good walking shoes.

Is there a fee collected at the program?

No. For incoming freshmen, the cost for Fusion New Student Orientation is included in the one-time New Student Fee (\$300). The New Student Fee is applied to your student account at the beginning of your first semester at EMU.

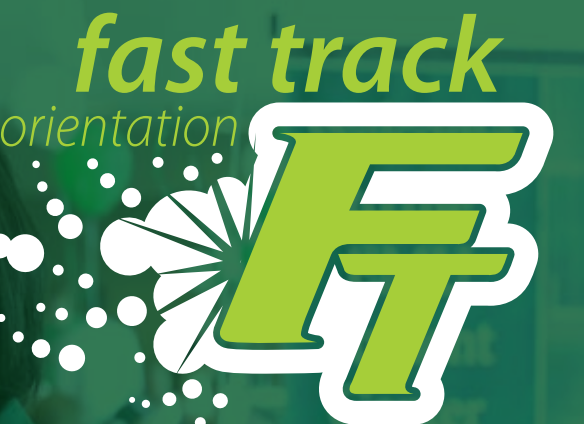
