A new grant for programming expenses related to an innovative AS-L class program/project at EMU.

GRANT RANGE: \$500-\$2000

POSSIBLE USE OF FUNDS: Supplies, materials, speakers, transportation

DEADLINE: April 13, 2009

REQUIREMENTS:

1. Must be a previous or current EMU AS-L Faculty Fellow*
2. Complete application and budget
3. Grant applications must include the following criteria:
 - Project must use service as a vehicle to deliver curriculum of a project or course
 - Service must meet a real university and community need
 - Students must participate and have the opportunity to reflect on their service experience.
4. Lesson plans, project information and final reports must be allowed to be posted the Office of AS-L's web page with the purpose of encouraging best practices
5. All funds must be spent by **June 1, 2010**, or unused funds will be forfeited.
6. Grant recipients are required to provide the Office of AS-L with a completed final report by **June 1, 2010**.

* More than one faculty member may be involved on one project.
Cross disciplinary work is encouraged.
