Delta College – Associate in Business Studies in General Management
Eastern Michigan University – Bachelor of Business Administration with an Approved Business Major

Purpose: **Bring a copy of this articulation agreement to all advising sessions.**

This articulation agreement was developed to provide a smooth curriculum transition for students who want to earn an associate degree in General Management from Delta College and transfer to EMU to earn a Bachelor of Business Administration with an approved business major. The agreement is designed to minimize loss of credits and duplication of coursework in transferring.

Requirements:

1. Complete the General Management program at Delta as specified below and complete the coordinated program of study for the Bachelor of Business Administration at Eastern Michigan University. Any course substitutions should be made with the guidance of an advisor or counselor to assure that all requirements are met.
2. Students whose transcripts are endorsed as “MACRAO Satisfied” by the community college will only be required to meet EMU’s additional four general education requirements, indicated on the attached articulation guide with a “1” and listed below:
 - a) a course in advanced written composition, advanced speech, or a foreign language [OAT 152 at Delta]
 - b) a course in mathematical reasoning [MTH 120 or MTH 263 at Delta]
 - c) a cross-cultural course [LIT 228, 229, 260, 269, 274, 277, 278, or 285 at Delta]
 - d) a course in computer literacy [CST 133 or MGT 274 at Delta]

To use MACRAO, students should request a MACRAO evaluation of their transcript in the Community College Student Records or Registrar’s Office. Students who do not satisfy MACRAO will have to complete all of EMU’s general education requirements.

3. Only courses with a grade of “C” or better (2.0 on a 4.0 scale) will be accepted for transfer to EMU. A course completed with a grade of less than 2.0, which is counted toward graduation at the community college, may be used to satisfy MACRAO. However, the course will not transfer and will have to be repeated if it is a program requirement at EMU.
4. Under this agreement, EMU will waive the 60-hour rule and require that a minimum of 51 credit hours must be completed at the four-year college level, 21 hours of which must be in the program with 15 hours in the major, at the 300/400 level. A minimum of 124 credit hours, completed in-residence or accepted in transfer, is required for graduation.
5. A minimum cumulative GPA of 2.0 is required for admission to EMU. Students with a community college GPA of 3.0 or higher will be admitted directly to the College of Business without a probationary semester. Students whose community college GPA’s are less than 3.0 may apply and be conditionally admitted to the College of Business for the first semester at EMU and will be regularly admitted after successful completion of at least 12 credits at EMU with a minimum overall EMU (GPA) of 2.5.
6. Students should contact the College of Business Undergraduate Advising Office early, before completing an admission application to EMU. To facilitate the evaluation of transcript(s), students should enclose a copy of this articulation guide in their application to EMU and bring a copy of the articulation guide to all advising sessions.

Effective Dates: September 15, 2005 until September 15, 2008. If this agreement is not renewed, students who started this program, before the end of the effective period, will be given three additional years, to be admitted to EMU under the terms of this agreement. Students should meet with an advisor each year to determine if any changes have been made to the program at either institution.
