Lansing Community College – Associate in Business in Management

Eastern Michigan University – Bachelor of Business Administration (with an Approved Business Major)

Purpose:

Bring a copy of this articulation agreement to all advising sessions.

This articulation agreement is designed to provide a smooth curriculum transition for students who earn an Associate in Business from Lansing Community College and transfer to EMU to earn a Bachelor of Business Administration with any approved business major. The agreement is designed to minimize loss of credits and duplication of coursework.

Requirements:

1. Complete the Management Program at Lansing Community College and complete the coordinated program of study for the Bachelor of Business Administration degree at Eastern Michigan University. Any course substitutions should be made with the guidance of an advisor or counselor to assure that all requirements are met.
2. Students whose transcripts are endorsed as “MACRAO Satisfied” will only be required to meet EMU’s additional four general education requirements, noted with a “1” on the articulation guide and listed below:
 - a) A course in advanced written composition, advanced speech, or a foreign language [WRIT 127 at LCC]
 - b) A course in mathematical reasoning [MATH 130 at LCC]
 - c) A cross-cultural course [ENGL 260, ENGL 270, HIST 150, or HIST 240 at LCC]
 - d) A course in computer literacy [CITF 110 or 200 at LCC] or [IS 215 at EMU]

To use MACRAO, students must request a MACRAO evaluation of their transcript from the LCC Registration and Records Office. Students who do not satisfy MACRAO will have to complete all of EMU’s general education requirements.

3. Only courses with a grade of “C” or better (2.0 on a 4.0 scale) will be accepted for transfer to EMU. Only courses in which at least a 2.0 is received will be applied to MACRAO by LCC.
4. Under this agreement, EMU will waive the 60-hour rule and require that a minimum of 36 credit hours must be completed at EMU, 21 hours of which must be in the major/program with 15 of those hours at the 300/400 level. A minimum of 124 credit hours is required for graduation.
5. A minimum cumulative GPA of 2.0 is required for admission to EMU. Students with a community college GPA of 3.0 or higher will be admitted directly to the College of Business without a probationary semester. Students whose community college GPA’s are less than 3.0 may apply and be conditionally admitted to the College of Business for the first semester at EMU and will be regularly admitted after successful completion of at least 12 credits at EMU with a minimum overall EMU (GPA) of 2.5.
6. Students should contact the College of Business Undergraduate Advising Office early, before completing an admission application to EMU. To facilitate the evaluation of transcript(s), students should attach a copy of this articulation guide in their application to EMU and bring a copy of the articulation guide to all advising sessions.

Effective Dates: December 15, 2005 until December 15, 2008. If this agreement is not renewed students, who started this program before the end of the effective period, will be given three additional years to be admitted to EMU under the terms of this agreement. Students should meet with an advisor each year to determine if any changes have been made to the program at either institution.
