ARTICULATION GUIDE

Monroe County Community College – Associate of Applied Science in Business Management Eastern Michigan University – Bachelor of Business Administration (with an Approved Business Major)

Purpose:

Bring a copy of this articulation agreement to all advising sessions.

This articulation agreement is designed to provide a smooth curriculum transition for students who want to complete the Business Management program at Monroe County Community College and transfer to EMU to earn a Bachelor of Business Administration with any approved business major. The agreement is designed to minimize loss of credits and duplication of coursework.

Requirements:

1. Complete the coordinated program of study for the Business Management program at Monroe County Community College and the Bachelor of Business Administration program at EMU as indicated on the following pages of this guide. Course substitutions should be made with the guidance of the College of Business Undergraduate Advisor to assure that all requirements are met.
2. Students whose transcripts are endorsed as “MACRAO Satisfied” will only be required to meet EMU’s additional four general education requirements, noted with a “1” on the articulation guide and listed below:
 - a) A course in advanced written composition, speech, or a foreign language [MGMT 202 at EMU]
 - b) A course in mathematical reasoning [MATH 251 at MCCC] or [MATH 118 or 122 at EMU]
 - c) A cross-cultural course [ENGL 255 at MCCC] or [approved course at EMU]
 - d) A course in computer literacy [CIS 130 at MCCC] or [IS 215 at EMU]

To use MACRAO, students must request a MACRAO evaluation of their transcript from the MCCC Registration and Records Office. Students who do not satisfy MACRAO will have to complete all of EMU’s general education requirements.

3. Only courses with a grade of “C” or better (2.0 on a 4.0 scale) will be accepted for transfer to EMU. A course completed with a grade of less than 2.0, even though it is counted toward graduation at the community college and used to satisfy MACRAO, will not transfer and will have to be repeated if it is a requirement of the Business program at EMU.
4. Under this agreement, EMU will waive the 60-hour rule and require that a minimum of 30 credit hours must be taken in EMU coursework, 15 hours of which must be program requirements at the 300- level or higher. Of the last 30 hours completed before graduating, at least 10 hours must be in courses offered by EMU. A minimum of 124 credit hours, completed in-residence or accepted in transfer, is required for graduation.
5. A minimum cumulative GPA of 2.0 is required for admission to EMU. Students with a community college GPA of 3.0 or higher will receive priority admission to the College of Business without a probationary semester. Students whose community college GPA’s are less than 3.0 may apply and be conditionally admitted to the College of Business for the first semester at EMU and will be regularly admitted after successful completion of at least 12 credits at EMU with a minimum overall EMU (GPA) of 2.5.
6. Students should contact the College of Business Undergraduate Advisor early, before completing an admission application to EMU. To facilitate the evaluation of transcript(s), students should include a copy of this articulation guide in their application to EMU and bring a copy to all advising sessions.

Effective Dates: September 1, 2006 until September 1, 2009. In the fall semester of 2007 this agreement will be updated to be consistent with EMU’s new general education requirements. MCCC students, who began this articulated program prior to fall 2007, may continue to follow the requirements in place at the time they started. Students who begin at MCCC during or after the fall semester of 2007 will have to satisfy the new General Education or MACRAO plus four requirements. If this agreement is not renewed at the end of the effective period, students who already began the program will have an additional three years to be admitted to EMU under the terms of the agreement. Students who began the program at MCCC prior to the effective date may use this agreement.
