Oakland Community College – Associate in Business Administration

Eastern Michigan University – Bachelor of Business Administration (with any approved business major)

Purpose:

Bring a copy of this articulation agreement to all advising sessions.

This articulation agreement is designed to provide a smooth curriculum transition for students who earn an Associate in Business Administration from Oakland Community College and transfer to EMU to earn a Bachelor of Business Administration with any approved business major. The agreement is designed to minimize loss of credits and duplication of coursework.

Requirements:

1. Complete the coordinated program of study for the Associate in Business Administration at Oakland Community College and the Bachelor of Business Administration program at EMU as indicated in this guide. Course substitutions should be made with the guidance of an advisor or counselor to assure that all requirements are met.
2. Students whose transcripts are endorsed as “MACRAO Satisfied” will only be required to meet EMU’s additional four general education requirements, noted with a “1” on the articulation guide and listed below:
 - a) A course in advanced written composition, advanced speech, or a foreign language [ENG 2200 at OCC]
 - b) A course in mathematical reasoning [MAT 1500 at OCC]
 - c) A cross-cultural course [ENG 1610, HIS 2610, or HIS 2620 at OCC]
 - d) A course in computer literacy [CIS 1050 or CIS 1100 at OCC]

To use MACRAO, students must request a MACRAO evaluation of their transcript from the OCC Registrar’s Office. Students who do not satisfy MACRAO will have to complete all of EMU’s general education requirements.

3. Only courses with a grade of “C” or better (2.0 on a 4.0 scale) will be accepted for transfer to EMU. A Course completed with a grade of less than 2.0, which is counted toward graduation at the community college, may be used to satisfy the MACRAO general education requirements. However, the course will not transfer and will have to be repeated if it is a requirement of the business major at EMU.
4. A minimum of 60 semester hours must be completed at the four-year college/university level. Of the last 30 semester hours prior to the granting of a bachelor’s degree, at least 10 hours must be completed in courses offered by EMU. A minimum of 124 credit hours, completed in-residence or accepted in transfer, is required for graduation.
5. A minimum cumulative GPA of 2.0 is required for admission to EMU. Students with a community college GPA of 3.0 or higher will receive priority admission to the College of Business without a probationary semester. Students whose community college GPA’s are less than 3.0 may apply and be conditionally admitted to the College of Business for the first semester at EMU and will be regularly admitted after successful completion of at least 12 credits at EMU with a minimum overall EMU (GPA) of 2.5.
6. Students should contact the College of Business Undergraduate Advising Office early, before completing an admission application to EMU. To facilitate the evaluation of transcript(s), students should enclose a copy of this articulation guide in their application to EMU and bring a copy of the articulation guide to all advising sessions.

Effective Dates: August 1, 2004 until August 1, 2009. If this agreement is not renewed, students who started this program, before the end of the effective period, will be given three additional years, to be admitted to EMU under the terms of this agreement. Students should meet with an advisor each year to determine if any changes have been made to the program at either institution.
