Schoolcraft College – Associate in Arts or Associate in General Studies Eastern Michigan University – Bachelor of Science in Social Work

Purpose:

Bring a copy of this articulation agreement to all advising sessions.

This articulation agreement is designed to provide a smooth curriculum transition for students who earn an Associate in Arts or Associate in General Studies Degree from Schoolcraft College and transfer to EMU to earn a Bachelor of Science in Social Work. The agreement is designed to minimize loss of credits and duplication of coursework.

Requirements:

1. Complete the coordinated program of study for an Associate in Arts or Associate in General Studies degree at Schoolcraft College and the Bachelor of Science in Social Work at Eastern Michigan University as specified in this articulation guide. Any course substitutions should be made with the guidance of an advisor or counselor to assure that all requirements are met.
2. Students whose transcripts are endorsed as “MACRAO Satisfied” by the community college will be required to meet EMU’s additional four general education requirements, indicated on the attached articulation guide with a “1”, and listed below:
 - a) a course in advanced written composition, advanced speech, or a foreign language [ENG 221, COMA 200, 203, FR 101, 102, SPAN 101, or 102 at Schoolcraft]
 - b) a course in mathematical reasoning [MATH 122 at Schoolcraft]
 - c) a cross-cultural course [ANTH 214 at Schoolcraft]
 - d) a course in computer literacy [CIS 115 or CIS 120 at Schoolcraft]

To use MACRAO, students should request a MACRAO evaluation of their transcript in the Community College Registrar’s Office. Students who do not satisfy MACRAO will have to complete all of EMU’s general education requirements.

3. Only courses with a grade of “C” or better (2.0 on a 4.0 scale) will be accepted for transfer to EMU.
4. Under this agreement, EMU will waive the 60-hour rule and require only that a minimum of 52 credit hours must be taken at the four-year college level, 30 hours of which must be at EMU, with 15 hours in the major at the 300-level or above. A minimum of 124 credit hours, completed in-residence or accepted in transfer, is required for graduation.
5. A minimum cumulative GPA of 2.0 is required for admission to EMU. A minimum cumulative GPA of 2.3 is required for admission to the Social Work program.
6. Eligibility for placement in the required two semesters of senior-year field placement includes: a cumulative GPA of 2.3 in all EMU courses (must be maintained through field placement), a minimum grade of “C” in each required SWRK course, completion of all required social work courses through the 300 level (including the courses that fulfill Life Span Human Growth & Development and Abnormal Psychology).
7. Students should contact an EMU advisor early, before completing an admission application to EMU. To facilitate the evaluation of transcript(s), students should enclose a copy of this articulation guide in their application to EMU and bring a copy of the articulation guide to all advising sessions.
8. Application to the Social Work program is completed while enrolled in SWRK 251. Students cannot enroll in the 300/400 level social work courses at EMU without seeing an advisor. SWRK 120, 251, and 222 are pre-requisites for all upper division SWRK courses and must be completed before starting the professional sequence at EMU. Students may enroll in these EMU courses at the Livonia Regional Center during the last two semesters of enrollment at Schoolcraft.

Effective Dates: June 15, 2004. This agreement has been **extended to September 1 2007**. If this agreement is not renewed by the end of the effective period, students who have designated and begun this articulated program before its termination will be given three additional years to be admitted to EMU under the terms of this agreement. Students are responsible for checking with a program advisor annually to determine if any changes have been made to the program.
