Articulation Agreement Discontinuation

The articulation agreement between Washtenaw Community College and Eastern Michigan University for the Bachelor of Science in Clinical Laboratory Science has been discontinued as of fall 2007. Students enrolling at WCC in fall 2007 or later should use the Clinical Laboratory Science transfer guide.

Students who started the requirements for this articulated program prior to September 2007 will be allowed three years (until August 31, 2010) to transfer to EMU under the terms of the agreement.

The Associate in Science General Studies Degree in Math and Natural Sciences at Washtenaw Community College was discontinued at the end of the 2003-04 academic year. Students enrolled for the first time at WCC beginning Fall 2004 or later do not have the option to earn the Associate in Science General Studies Degree. Courses earned in the process of completing this articulation agreement apply toward the requirements of other current degrees.

EMU will not require students to complete a degree at WCC as part of the agreement. Students should contact Gary Hammerberg, Medical Technology Program Director, for help in making a plan to complete the program at EMU.
