**Washtenaw Community College –AAS in Radiography or Nursing or Certificate in Dental Assisting
Eastern Michigan University – Bachelor of Science in Health Administration)**

Purpose:

Bring a copy of this articulation agreement to all advising sessions.

This 3 + 1 articulation agreement is designed to provide a smooth curriculum transition for students in the Radiography Nursing, or Dental Assisting programs at WCC who want to transfer to EMU to earn a Bachelor of Science in Health Administration. The agreement is designed to minimize loss of credits and duplication of coursework in transferring.

Requirements:

1. Complete the coordinated program of study for the AAS in Radiography (or Nursing or the Certificate in Dental Assisting) at Washtenaw Community College and the Bachelor of Science in Health Administration at Eastern Michigan University as indicated in this articulation guide. Any course substitutions should be made with the guidance of an advisor or counselor to assure that all requirements are met.
2. Students whose transcripts are endorsed as “MACRAO Satisfied” will only be required to meet EMU’s additional four general education requirements, noted with a “1” on the articulation guide and listed below:
 - a) A course in advanced written composition, advanced speech, or a foreign language [ENG 226 at WCC]
 - b) A course in mathematical reasoning [MTH 160 at WCC] or [SOCL 250 at EMU]
 - c) A cross-cultural course [ART 143, ART 150, ENG 181, or ENG 214 at WCC]
 - d) A course in computer literacy [CIS 100, CIS 110, or CPS 120 at WCC] or [an approved course at EMU]*To use MACRAO, students must request a MACRAO evaluation of their transcript from the WCC Registration and Records Office. Students who do not satisfy MACRAO will have to complete all of EMU’s general education requirements.*
3. Only courses with a grade of “C” or better (2.0 on a 4.0 scale) will be accepted for transfer to EMU. A Course completed with a grade of less than 2.0, which is counted toward graduation at the community college, may be used to satisfy the MACRAO agreement. However, the course will not transfer and will have to be repeated if it is a requirement of the Health Administration program.
4. Under this agreement, EMU will waive the 60-hour rule and require that a minimum of 30 credit hours must be taken at EMU, 15 hours of which must be in program requirements, at the 300-level or above. Of the last 30 hours completed before graduating, at least 10 hours must be in courses offered by EMU. A minimum of 124 credit hours, completed in-residence or accepted in transfer, is required for graduation.
5. Students must meet all admission requirements at the time of application for admission to EMU, including submitting transcripts from all previously attended colleges.
6. Students should contact the EMU Health Administration program Coordinator early, before completing an admission application to EMU. To facilitate the evaluation of transcript(s), students should enclose a copy of this articulation guide in their application to EMU and bring a copy of the articulation guide to all advising sessions.

Effective Dates: June 20, 2004. This agreement has been **extended until September 1, 2007**. If the agreement is not renewed, students who started this program at the community college before the termination of the agreement, will have three additional years to be admitted to EMU under the terms of the agreement. Students who began this program at the community college prior to the effective date may use this articulation agreement to the extent that the curriculum followed is consistent with this agreement.
