### Additional Information:

1. In completing the coordinated program of study for this articulation agreement, course substitutions should be made with the guidance of the advisors (indicated below) at both institutions to assure that all requirements are satisfied. Courses indicated with an \* are required for EMU's Social Work Program.
2. Students whose transcripts are endorsed as "MACRAO Satisfied" will only be required to meet EMU's three general education requirements, noted with a "1" on the articulation guide and listed below. These requirements may be completed, as listed in this guide, at the most appropriate time for the student whether before or after admission to EMU.
  - a) an approved course in Quantitative Reasoning: [MATH 133, 140, or 145, or 151 at JCC]
  - b) an approved course in Global Awareness or US Diversity: [ANT 131, ENG 236, 249, 257; GEO 132; HIST 125; MUS 130; SOC 235, 236 at JCC]
  - c) an approved Learning beyond the Classroom course or experience offered by EMU [SWRK 350, 488, 489 at EMU]*To use MACRAO, students should request a MACRAO evaluation of their transcript from the community college Student Records or Registrar's Office. Students who do not satisfy MACRAO will have to satisfy EMU's general education requirements as listed in the Undergraduate Catalog.*
3. Only courses with a grade of "C" or better (2.0 on a 4.0 scale) will be accepted for transfer to EMU.
4. Under this agreement, EMU will waive the 60-hour rule and require that a minimum of 56 credit hours must be completed at the four-year college level, of which 30 hours must be in courses offered by EMU. Of the last 30 hours completed before graduating, a minimum of 10 credit hours must be in courses offered by EMU. A minimum of 124 credit hours, completed in-residence or accepted in transfer, is required for graduation.
5. Eligibility for placement in the required two semesters of senior-year field placement includes:
  - a) A cumulative GPA of 2.3 in all EMU courses (must be maintained through field placement),
  - b) A minimum grade of "C" in each required SWRK course, completion of all required social work courses through the 300 level (including courses that fulfill Life Span Human Growth & Development and Abnormal Psychology),
  - c) A minimum of 40 hours (post high school) volunteer work, internship, or work-experience at a social welfare agency or organization that is documented by a reference letter from the supervisor of that experience. JCC internships may be used to satisfy this requirement.
  - d) A written essay on the student's interest in social work as a career.
6. Students must meet all admission requirements at the time of application for admission to EMU, including submitting transcripts from all previously attended colleges. JCC students will receive equal consideration with other students for course registration and financial aid.
7. Application to the Social Work program is completed while enrolled in SWRK 251. Students cannot enroll in the 300/400 level social work courses at EMU without seeing an advisor. SWRK 120, 200, 251, and 222 are pre-requisites for all upper division SWRK courses and must be completed before starting the professional sequence at EMU. Students may enroll in these courses at EMU's main campus or at an off-campus site during the last two semesters of enrollment at Jackson Community College.
8. Students are encouraged to contact the Social Work Program Coordinator early, before applying to EMU. To facilitate the evaluation of transcripts, enclose a copy of this articulation guide with the EMU application and bring a copy to all advising sessions. **Effective Dates: September 1, 2008 until August 31, 2011** If this agreement is not renewed at the end of the effective period, students who already started the program will be given three additional years to be admitted to EMU under the terms of this agreement.
