Construction Management Articulation Agreement Discontinuation

**Oakland Community College – AAS in Management Development-Construction Mgmt Option
Eastern Michigan University – Bachelor of Science in Construction Management**

The articulation agreement between OCC and EMU for the AAS in Management Development-Construction Management and the BS in Construction Management will be discontinued as of September 1, 2015.

Students who started the program at OCC prior to September 1, 2015 may continue to follow the Construction Management articulation agreement and will have three additional years (until August 31, 2018) to transfer to EMU under the terms of the agreement.
