## What Community Programs Can Help Us?

### Head Start (313) 202-0255

This program is free and helps children of low-income families with language, literacy, social and emotional development. The program is for children ages o-5 years old.

### Early On (800) 327-5966

This program is free for children ages o-3 years old who are at risk for developmental delays. It connects families with social, health, and educational resources.

### How Can I Get My Home Tested for Lead?

There are free services to have your home tested for lead. If your home has lead, you can apply for Lead Safe programs to fix your home. The Lead Safe programs are free or lowcost. There are programs for Hamtramck and Detroit, the application process is different depending on your zip code.
