<b>Comments:</b> This is a program that leads to earning Bachelors and Masters degrees upon program completion. Over the most recent 3-year reporting interval (2005-2008) for the speech and language impairment Michigan Test for Teacher Certification (MTTC) test, 22 of 22 teacher candidates passed the MTTC. Program review was conducted by the Council on Academic Accreditation in Audiology and Speech-Language Pathology (CAA). The CAA re-accredited this program for 8 years, June 1, 2009 through May 31, 2017. Regular annual reports to the CAA are expected, beginning August 1, 2010.
