



Where Should I Go For ADVISING From Now On?

Welcome to EMU! Undergraduate students who are interested in **teacher certification** with their bachelor's degree can access advising services throughout the year. The following table explains where you should go for individual advising.

<i>Business/Marketing, Technology, and Vocational Education</i>	Make an appointment with an advisor in the School of Technology Studies within EMU's College of Technology.	The School of Technology Studies is in 122 Sill Hall (734-487-1161).	As soon as possible.
<i>Elementary Education (i.e. teachers in grades K-8)</i>	Step 1): Attend one <u>Elementary</u> Group Advising session <u>as soon as possible</u> . Group advising is required of all elementary students. Step 2): Make an individual appointment with an advisor in the Department of Teacher Education for individual advising.	The Department of Teacher Education is located in 313 Porter Building (734-487-3260). Advisors are available <u>after</u> you have attended group advising.	As soon as possible. <u>Transfer students</u> should attend group advising by their second semester at the community college.
<i>Music Education (K-12)</i>	Make an appointment with an advisor in the Department of Music & Dance.	The Department of Music & Dance is in N101 Alexander Building (734-487-1044).	As soon as possible.
<i>Physical Education (K-12)</i>	Make an appointment with an advisor in the School of Health Promotion and Human Performance	The School of HP& HP is located in 318 Porter Building (734-487-0090).	As soon as possible.
<i>Secondary Education (i.e. subjects taught in grades 6-12 including Visual Arts Education)</i>	Step 1): Attend one <u>Secondary</u> Group Advising session <u>as soon as possible</u> . Group advising is required of all secondary students. Step 2): Make an individual appointments with an advisors in the Department of Teacher Education, your major department, and your minor department for individual advising.	The Department of Teacher Education is located in 313 Porter Building (734-487-3260). Advisors are available <u>after</u> you have attended group advising.	As soon as possible. <u>Transfer students</u> should attend group advising by their second semester at the community college.
<i>Special Education (grades K-12)</i>	Make an appointment with a faculty advisor in the Department of Special Education to find out about program requirements, admission requirements, deadlines, etc. Group advising is <u>not</u> part of your advising process.	The Department of Special Education is located in 128 Porter Building (734-487-3300).	As soon as possible.
