

# Pre-Student Teaching Requirements

**100 hours of pre-student teaching are required of all initial teacher certification students**

(These hours must be less than three years old at the time you student teach)

## **Follow this program if you started college at EMU or elsewhere: PRIOR TO FALL 1998**

### **1. Complete 50 hours in a classroom:**

- a) **50** hours must be in the classroom setting under a certified classroom teacher in your major with age appropriate students, e.g. Secondary: 7-12
- b) Must have at least **two** different experiences, one of which is in a multicultural or urban classroom.
- c) Students may complete all **100** hours of pre-student teaching in a classroom.
- d) Students may count **20** hours of substitute teaching toward experiences in the classroom [Elementary K-5, Secondary 7-12 in major only].

### **2. Outside the classroom pre-student teaching:**

Other **50** hours of work with students may be in a teaching/learning setting with age-appropriate students in grades listed above, for example:

Tutoring      Coaching      Structured religious instruction  
Instruction within scouting, after school activities, or recreational programs

### **3. Purchase Pre-student Teaching Coursepack at Ned's.**

- a) Complete exercises **1-20** and any other activities that are appropriate to your situation or that are assigned.
- b) Log hours working with students outside the classroom in the back of the Pre-Student Teaching Coursepack.

### **4. Submit the completed Pre-Student Teaching Coursepack to: 206 Porter before Student Teaching.**

## **Follow this program if you started college at EMU or elsewhere: FALL 1998 TO DATE**

### **1. Complete 60 hours through FETE field experiences:**

- a) Students must complete three 1 cr. hr. field experiences:  
Secondary: FETE 201, 302, 402

These are co-requisites with professional education courses. See required professional education requirements. These courses meet **60** credit hours of classroom experience.

- b) Must have at least **two** different experiences, one of which is in a multicultural or urban classroom.

### **2. Additional pre-student teaching requirement:**

- a) **40** hours of additional pre-student teaching are required. These may be in a classroom or in a teaching/learning setting with students in grades 7 - 12, for example:

Tutoring      Coaching      Structured religious instruction  
Instruction within scouting, after school activities, or recreational programs

- b) Students may count **40** hours of substitute teaching toward additional pre-student teaching.

### **3. Purchase coursepacks that go along with FETE courses the semester you take them:**

- a) Complete course assignments that are in the FETE coursepack and that coincide with the co-requisite professional course/s. Record FETE hours on Green Card with instructor's signature.
- b) Log the additional **40** hours of pre-student teaching on Green Cards or submit valid proof of work for approval by Office of Academic Services, 206 Porter Building.

### **4. Submit completed assignments to: FETE supervisor and/or faculty teaching the co-requisite course.**

**Submit completed Green Card to: Office of Academic Services, 206 Porter.**
