1. Academic Integrity

a). NCAA Academic Requirements

In 2003, the NCAA initiated a process to track Academic Progress Rates (APR) and Graduation Success Rates (GSR). With these new NCAA initiatives, EMU academic reports are reviewed every semester. Teams rated below a 925 APR are required to develop an academic improvement plan. The FAR is actively involved with reviewing academic reports every semester and working with athletic staff to develop an academic improvement plan for teams below 925 APR.

The NCAA academic eligibility requirements outline the student athletes' academic progress which include that student athletes be enrolled in at least 12 credits, complete 6 credits each semester, complete 24 credits per year, and meet the minimum GPA requirements. Student athletes must meet the Progress toward Degree Requirements, which require completion of 40% of the credits toward degree before the third year, 60% before the fourth year, and 80% before the fifth year.

#### b). Academic Support Plan

Meet regularly with athletic advising staff to discuss and review issues and concerns regarding student athletes.

In response to developing the Academic Improvement Plans for teams below the 925, the athletic department initiated a university wide committee to review these plans (August-September). The FAR and the chair of the Inter-collegiate Athletic Advisory Committee (faculty council representative) serve on this committee.

#### c). Academic Excellence

- Three Student Athletes earned Academic All-American honors (only a handful of student athletes have received this recognition in the past).
- 35 Student Athletes earned Academic All-Mid American Conference honors.
- ESPN The Magazine recognized two Student Athletes as Academic All-American Honorees.
- Soccer (4th highest GPA in Nation).
- Volleyball received the American Volleyball Coaches Association Award for its 3.346 team GPA (One out of 55 NCAA Div I institutions).
- Softball (8th highest GPA in Nation in 2006).
- Eleven teams had a 3.0 GPA or higher 2006-07.
- 218 student athletes had a 3.2 GPA.

**Missed Class** Unlike other institutions, Eastern Michigan University does not have a Policy missed class policy for STUDENTS. Many institutions have developed a missed class policy for all students involved in activities supporting their academic success, for such activities as, Model United Nations, Forensic Competitions, musical events, athletic competition, and other field trips.

I would like to request the Faculty Councils' input committee, Inter Collegiate Advisory Council, to consider working with the academic affairs and student affairs to develop a missed class policy for all students.

Meanwhile, I hope that faculty colleagues continue to understand the limits on student athlete's time and accommodate a student athlete just as if the student athlete represented another student organization, such as, Model United Nations, forensics competitions, debate teams, etc.

system that promotes checks and balances broke down because, apparently it was easier to let these complaints go through than to cut them off at the pass. In my opinion, it is ridiculous to allow students to choose between a departmental level grievance or a COE level grievance when they have, already built in, the right to appeal. Further, I am horrified that those responding to a COE level grievance would treat a faculty colleague as a leper simply because a complaint had been filed. The most troubling part of being helpful to my colleague was hearing other colleagues suggest that she lower her standards to match the “mid-level of competency” of our students. One faculty colleague who advised her of this and spoke extensively about “dumbing down our expectations” later wrote a letter on behalf of one of the students filing a complaint without indicating her intent to do this to the faculty colleague. Ironically, those of us in a helping position found no “strength and honor” in that move. There is seriously something amiss with a system of grievance which provides a platform for students to make outrageous and racism statements, yet insists that the person being accused remain quiet, tempered and professional.
