

Policy on 12-Hour Rule for Transfer Students From 2- and 4- Year Colleges and Universities

Proposal: It is proposed that the following statement will be added to the existing catalog language:

The requirement that students must “have earned 12-credit hours at EMU, including at least one course in the major” will be waived for transfer students who:

1. Have an overall 3.00 or greater grade point average (on a 4:00 point scale).
2. Meet all other requirements for admission to a teacher certification program (e.g., pass the Basic Skills Test, earn a minimum of 56 credit hours, etc.).

Students admitted to the College of Education under this policy must enroll in at least one course in the major during their first semester at EMU.

It is further recommended that this policy become effective immediately upon passage by the College of Education Council and being signed by the Dean of the College of Education.
