Spanish Notes:

Spanish Major for Secondary Teacher Certification

A minimum of 30 semester hours of Spanish coursework beyond second-year proficiency is required.
Prerequisite: SPNH 222 or equivalent Spanish-language proficiency (hours do not count toward major).

Majors must also enroll in the methods course FLAN 411 Theory and Methods of Modern-Language Teaching (3 credit hours).

Spanish Minor for Elementary, Secondary, K-12, Special Education-Elementary and Special Education-Secondary Teacher Certification

A minimum of 20 semester hours of Spanish coursework beyond second-year proficiency is required.
Prerequisite: SPNH 222 or equivalent Spanish-language proficiency (hours do not count toward major).

Minors must also enroll in the methods course FLAN 411 Theory and Methods of Modern-Language Teaching (3 credit hours).
