 - Has a planned program of study and has completed 18 hours of the planned program of study and maintained a 3.5 GPA.
 - Must apply for scholarship and write a 300 word essay/letter describing how he/she plans to develop his/her full potential/goals for a career in helping, the need for financial assistance, and the reasons that he/she is deserving of the award.
 - Must submit one page resume/vita and two letters of recommendation that focus on the individual's integrity, compassion for others, ethical behavior and commitment to serious study of counseling principles, practices and theories.
