

APPROVED MAJORS AND MINORS FOR SECONDARY CERTIFICATION

Secondary certification is for a person who wishes to teach grades 6-12 in his/her major and minor. A few majors include an endorsement to teach grades K-12; those are marked accordingly. Michigan Test for Teacher Certification (MTTC) subject area tests in the major and minor will be required for certification.
