### UNDERGRADUATE SCHOLARSHIPS

#### **Fuller, Grace Endowed Scholarship (Dean's Office)**

Awarded to junior or senior majoring in Department of Human, Environmental, and Consumer Resources or any subsequent name the department might bear (ATM, HRM, IDE) ; cumulative 3.0 GPA and selection based upon scholarly performance and leadership potential.

#### **Sanderson, Frances G. Endowed Scholarship (Dean's Office)**

Awarded undergraduate in IDE, ATM, HRM programs who demonstrate leadership ability, motivation, and commitment along with scholastic performance. Financial need may be considered.

#### **Sarns, Richard & Norma Scholarship (Dean's Office)**

Awarded to College of Technology students who have a cumulative 3.0 GPA or above. Must be enrolled in a minimum of 12 credit hours for the semester the award is granted; priority will be given to high school graduates and then to currently enrolled EMU students.

#### **Seaver, Jay J. Scholarship (Dean's Office)**

Awarded to College of Technology junior or senior student who exhibit superior academic performance; preference given to minority students and selection based on student's academic record.

#### **Wright, Fred C. (Dean's Office)**

Awarded to junior or seniors enrolled in the construction management program with a cumulative 3.0 GPA.

### SCHOOL OF ENGINEERING TECHNOLOGY

#### **College of Technology Coatings Scholarship (SET)**

Awarded to Polymers and Coatings declared major students who have a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or above; should have an interest and desire to work in the paint and coatings industry.

#### **Ervin Industries Scholarship (SET)**

Awarded to students (entering college for the first time or transfer students) must have an interest to work in the Industrial Technology field and intend to major with a degree from the School of Engineering Technology; a cumulative 2.5 GPA required; must be enrolled as a part-time student (6 credit hour minimum).

#### **Graham, John C. Memorial Scholarship (SET)**

Awarded to Polymers & Coating majors (all academic levels will be considered) who have a 3.0 GPA or above.

#### **Industrial Power Systems Inc. Construction Management (SET)**

Awarded to Construction Management students with a 2.8 GPA or above; preference given to child/grandchild of current Industrial Power System employee or child/grandchild of furnished list of a construction trade organization.

#### **Parker, Charles H. Scholarship (SET)**

Awarded to students in the Polymers & Coatings curriculum. Selection made at the discretion of the department head or program coordinator.

#### **Seaver, Virginia Endowed Scholarship (SET)**

Awarded to the students who place first in the Junior Review process in the Interior Design program.

#### **Surovell, Natalie Scholarship (SET)**

Awarded to students majoring in Interior Design and show need of financial assistance. Financial need to be expressed in essay on application.

#### **The Lilly Industries, Inc. Scholarship (SET)**

Awarded to full-time junior status students majoring in Polymers and Coatings with cumulative 3.0 GPA.

### **Thomson, Carolyn Mar Scholarship (SET)**

Awarded to Computer-Aided Manufacturing/Product Design & Development majors with a cumulative 3.0 GPA; preference given to female applicants. Industrial Technology students majoring in other areas and meet other requirements may receive an award.

### **Weeks, Dr. John A. Scholarship (SET)**

Awarded to Construction Management (CM) majors who are members of Eastern Constructors and have earned a minimum of 48 credit hours toward a CM degree. The applicant must also have at least one full academic year left subsequent to the application deadline.

## **SCHOOL OF TECHNOLOGY STUDIES**

### **ASA Scholarship (STS)**

Awarded to undergraduate College of Technology students in good academic standing who demonstrate financial need. Write a 1-2 page essay/letter describing how you meet the criteria and deserves the award (i.e. personal financial situation, professional experience and career goals). Currently registered, provide the donor with yearly progress reports and post-graduation plans.

### **Buchanan, Polly and Jim Scholarship (STS)**

Awarded to Hospitality Management major at the sophomore level or above (at least 25 credit hours completed including graduate students); have a 2.3 GPA or higher and dedication to completing degree, interest in the hospitality industry by shown work experience and/or support for the student club or other industry related activities. The student can only receive the award once.

### **Coca Cola Endowed Scholarship (STS)**

Awarded to students who earned 56 credits toward their degree; having completed their first HRM cooperative study rotation and are in good academic standing. Financial need may be considered – it will not be one of the required criteria for awarding the scholarship.

### **Cullen, Mary Scholarship (STS)**

Awarded to students with a declared major in Communications Technology; cumulative EMU GPA of 3.0 or better; financial need as determined by the School of Technology Studies.

### **Gayleard, Rhona M. Scholarship (STS)**

Awarded to Business Education majors who have a 3.0 GPA or above.

### **Rini, John /AMS Detroit Area Chapter Scholarship (STS)**

Awarded to a student that participate in the EMU Administrative Management Society college chapter; junior standing or above; declared major in administrative management area with evidence of leadership and service.

### **Robinson, Julius M. Scholarship (STS)**

Awarded to students majoring in Business Education (then secondary education if such curriculum is not offered) who have completed 75 credit hours, junior standing with one full semester taken at EMU and have achieved an outstanding record that semester.

### **W.W. Grainger (STS)**

Awarded to junior or senior Industrial Distribution students. Must have completed 9 credit hours toward the Industrial Distribution degree. Must demonstrate merit through course work or service in the Industrial distribution profession or a combination of both.

### **Technology Solutions (STS)**

Awarded to Communication Technology majors achieving junior or senior status with a cumulative 2.7 GPA with preference given to Technology Solutions employees. Recipients are encouraged to participate in internship while receiving scholarship.

### **Willoughby, George A. Memorial Scholarship (STS)**

Awarded to Industrial Education students with outstanding achievement and/or outstanding promise for contribution in the field of industrial education.

### **Wingo, Dr. Rose C. Scholarship (STS)**

Awarded to Business Education majors with a cumulative 2.5 GPA; completed BMMT 200; student are to express in writing a desire to become a teacher; enrolled in a minimum of 8 credit hours during the semester the award is granted.

Returning COT student who has participated in EMU's graduate research fair.
