TERMS AND CONDITIONS

We expect that students will take reasonable care of the texts, materials, and equipment and return them in good condition at the end of the semester so that other students can enjoy this benefit.

- ✓ At the start of term, each student will receive an itemized list that shows the value of the books and materials for which they are responsible.
- ✓ All textbooks and materials must be returned at the final exam. Each student will receive a copy of the original book loan form that also shows that they returned their books in good condition.
- ✓ The Internal Revenue Service requires Eastern Michigan University and the CSIE Program to report the value of any books not returned to the program.
- ✓ Any student who wants to keep their textbooks for personal reference may reimburse the CSIE Program at the end of term.
- ✓ When text editions are retired, the CSIE program will contact former students and offer the used texts on a first-come-first-serve basis.
