The major in economics requires taking TEN classes in Economics. FIVE classes are required in the minor and FIVE are to be chosen by students as electives. It is recommended that students use the five elective courses to complete their knowledge and to help prepare for their career choice or postgraduate education. Consultation with an advisor when making choices on elective courses is essential.

NOTE: The requirement is that you take either Econ 310 or Econ 415. Each course has different prerequisites that will determine your ability to take the one of your choice. It is possible to take both courses and have them count toward your 10 course requirement.

Elective Courses: For students who enroll at EMU beginning with the Fall Semester 2007, one of the five elective courses must be a writing intensive course. Writing intensive courses are identified as such in the online catalog and/or the class schedule. Contact the Economics Department for more information.
