- Write a personal statement addressing the positions that interest you and your qualifications for those positions and send that statement to Professor Russ Larson (see above):

- Make sure that your recommendation letters address your qualifications for a GA position. You may submit the same recommendation letters for both admissions and your GA application, or, if you choose, you can submit separate letters. If you use the same letters, you simply need to have one copy of them sent to Graduate Admissions. If you use different letters, send your GA recommendation letters to Professor Russ Larson (see above).
