All graduate students are required to join the Grad Students in English Group on My.Emich. The Grad Students in English Group is designed to be an informational and social hub for students in all graduate programs offered by the Department of English Language and Literature. Joining this group ensures your access to up to date information on deadlines, events, opportunities and news.

Features include:

- *Announcements* regarding deadlines, events, awards
- *News articles* letting you know what your professors and peers are up to
- *Files* featuring documents like the Graduate Student Handbook, Graduate Assistantship application forms.
- *Web links* giving you access web sites useful for your graduate studies
- *Email* function that allows you to contact each other (as long as you know each others' names)
- *Message Board* and *Chat* functions that will allow you to easily organize events, study groups, sell or trade textbooks, etc.

To join the *Grad Students in English Group*:

Note: You must have set up your my.emich email account. You need this email address to join the Group.

1. Go to your my.emich homepage
2. Click on the “groups” icon in the upper right hand corner
3. Choose the Groups Index tab
4. Choose the “Academic” category in the Group Studio column
5. Find *Grad Students in English* in the alphabetical list
6. Click on the link and then click on the button: “Join Group”

Once you’ve been accepted, you’ll find that clicking on the “Groups” icon will take you immediately to a “My Groups” page that includes the link to our group. Click on this link, and browse away.
