

Irene Little Wallace Scholarship: This scholarship comes with a minimum, one-time award of \$500. Students applying for the award must be undergraduate majors in English with a GPA of at least 3.0 and demonstrated financial need. Applications are due in hard-copy to the English Department in Pray-Harold and should be directed to the attention of Professor Melissa Jones. Students who do not receive the award upon first application are encouraged to resubmit. Deadlines for submission are listed below. To apply, a student must submit the following:

Students applying for the award must be declared undergraduate majors or minors in English, must have a minimum GPA of 3.0, and must demonstrate leadership in University or community activities.
