



## **IELTS Test Day Information**

- 8:00 a.m.-8:45 a.m.: Registration \*Please arrive before 8:45 AM.\*
- 9:00 a.m.- 12:00 p.m.: Listening, Reading, and Writing modules \*\*We do not use headsets for the listening section. Audio is played through a high quality auditorium sound system.\*\*
- 1:00 p.m.- 6:00 p.m.: Speaking exams occur on the same day in the afternoon. You will be given a room location and time. Requests for specific interview times or changes will not be granted. Plan



to stay at the center until your interview is complete.

## What to bring:

Bring your valid passport and a second form of identification. You may only bring your passport, glasses (no case), and a clear/transparent water bottle into the test room. All other belongings will be stored in a separate room and you will not have access to your personal items until you have finished your exam. We suggest leaving your personal belongings in your car. You will be given pencils by EMU IELTS. Please contact us before the test if you have any questions about what to bring.

## Late Arrivals

Candidates who arrive late will not be able to take the exam. Candidates will need to register for a new test and pay the test fee again.

**Complaint Process:** Complaints relating to the delivery of the test will not be accepted after test day. Inform the invigilator on the day of the test if you believe that your performance may be affected by ill health, by the way in which the test is delivered at the center or for any other reason. If you have a complaint relating to the delivery of the test, you must submit your complaint to the test center before you leave the center on test day. Please read the "Notice to Candidates" in your application for more information. Finally, scores cannot be issued until the complaint has been investigated and resolved.
