

SUMMER 2008 FULL-TIME WORK STUDY APPLICATION FOR NON-ENROLLED STUDENTS

Full-time work study provides employment opportunities for students who will not be enrolled during the summer semester. The funds earned help meet the educational expenses for the following fall and winter semesters. Students may work a maximum of 40 hours per week, but total earnings cannot exceed the summer work study award. The hourly pay rate is determined by the employer.

CRITERIA

To be eligible for full-time work study, you:

- Cannot be enrolled in classes during the summer semester. If a student is awarded full-time work study and enrolls for summer, earnings will be transferred to the employer's budget.
- Must have filed a 2007-08 and a 2008-09 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA), and have submitted all required documentation to the Office of Financial Aid.
- Must plan to enroll at EMU at least half-time for fall 2008 and register for classes by June 9, 2007.
- Must demonstrate need as determined by the FAFSA.
- A portion of the net earnings may be used as a resource in the determination of 2008-09 financial aid.

If you previously submitted an application for Summer 2008 aid (intending to be enrolled), this application will REPLACE IT.
