Formula to determine the maximum number of semesters of scholarship payment:

Semesters of Eligibility:  $124 - \text{transfer hours} = X \div 15 = \# \text{ of semesters (round up)}$

Ex:  $124 - 67 \text{ transfer hours} = 57 \div 15 = 3.8 \text{ semesters (rounded up to 4 semesters)}$
