| Regents Scholarship | <p>\$3,000 per year award (renewable) for new transfer students with a 3.7 cumulative college GPA and a minimum of 30 transferrable credit hours. The Regents Scholarship is automatically renewed each semester provided you:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Enroll in a minimum of 15 credit hours each semester of the award. • Maintain an EMU cumulative grade point average of 3.50 or higher for renewal each semester. • Meet the completion rate criteria as defined by EMU’s Satisfactory Academic Progress (SAP) policy. | Recognition of Excellence Scholarship | <p>\$2,000 per year award (renewable) for new transfer students with a 3.5 cumulative college GPA and a minimum of 30 transferrable credit hours. The Recognition of Excellence Scholarship is automatically renewed each semester provided you:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Enroll in a minimum of 12 credit hours each semester of the award. • Maintain an EMU cumulative grade point average of 3.30 or higher for renewal each semester. • Meet the completion rate criteria as defined by EMU’s Satisfactory Academic Progress (SAP) policy. | Transfer Scholarship | <p>\$1,000 one-year (\$500 fall/\$500 winter) award for new transfer students with a 3.0 cumulative college GPA and a minimum of 30 transferrable credit hours. The Transfer Scholarship is automatically paid each semester provided you:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Enroll in a minimum of 12 credit hours each semester of the award. If you enroll for fewer than 12 credit hours, the scholarship will be prorated to 75 percent or 50 percent based on actual part-time enrollment levels. |
| National Scholars Program | <p>\$13,700 per year award to incoming transfer students from states other than Michigan or Ohio. The award pays the difference between in-state and out-of-state tuition (Michigan and Ohio residents always pay in-state tuition). To be eligible for the program, students must have a minimum cumulative college GPA of 3.0 (on a 4.0 scale), and a minimum of 30 transferrable credit hours. If your residency status changes or if you are charged in-state tuition costs (such as for online classes), the National Scholars Program will be reduced or cancelled since it is awarded to pay towards the difference between in-state and out-of-state tuition costs. If you are awarded any other funding that pays the out-of-state differential, the National Scholars Program offer is null and void. The National Scholars Program award is automatically renewed each semester provided you:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Enroll in a minimum of 15 credit hours each semester of the award. • Maintain an EMU cumulative grade point average of 3.00 or higher for renewal each semester. • Meet the completion rate criteria as defined by EMU’s Satisfactory Academic Progress (SAP) policy. | Campus Housing Award | <p>\$1,000 per year award for students who live in an EMU residence hall. The Campus Housing Award is automatically renewed each semester provided you:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Live in the EMU residence halls • Retain eligibility for your academic scholarship based on the criteria listed above |
