

Inside this insert, we also introduce new staff at the Foundation and offer highlights of fund raising in fiscal year 2001-02. In summary, despite market volatility and dramatic philanthropic challenges this past year, the Foundation recorded \$3,464,678 in cash gifts. This represents a substantial increase over the prior year of 10.4 percent. Additionally, the market value of the endowment is \$30,517,632. Eagle Crest Management Corporation, the Foundation's wholly owned subsidiary, provided a dividend of \$50,000.

A measure of a University's impact and prestige is the commitment of its faculty, staff, alumni and friends. We thank those who have shared their time, talent and personal resources to ensure success at EMU.

Eastern Michigan University faculty and staff are no strangers to creating opportunities and ensuring success.

This theme, "Creating Opportunities, Ensuring Success," best describes the 16<sup>th</sup> Annual Faculty and Staff Campaign, which will begin its active phase with a breakfast for departmental representatives Wednesday, Nov. 13.

Serving as volunteer co-chairs for the second year are Amelia Chan, assistant dean, College of Business, and John McAuliffe, director, department of public safety.

"I am honored and pleased to co-chair the Faculty and Staff Campaign with John McAuliffe," Chan said. "This campaign is a great opportunity for the EMU community to give back to the institution where we work. One of the areas of crucial needs is increasing the funding for schol-

arships. In some cases, scholarships may determine whether the students can actually attend our University."

While the active phase of the annual campaign begins in November, faculty and staff may make a gift at any time during the fiscal year. Those using payroll deduction are encouraged to make a pledge

before Dec. 6.

"Payroll deduction is a popular and relatively easy way to make a gift," said Jennifer Mohill, who is directing this year's campaign. "Unlike other campaigns, 100 percent of your gift to the Faculty and Staff campaign goes to the area designated. No administrative fees are

deducted," she added.

Last year's campaign surpassed the goal by 15.9 percent and brought in more than \$350,000 in support of EMU. This year's goal is \$375,000, with increased participation another priority.

All faculty and staff are encouraged to designate their gift to expendable scholarships, endowed scholarships and the Partnership for Excellence Fund, which will assist with areas of greatest need.

To generate excitement and draw attention to this year's campaign, donuts and apples will be delivered to all EMU departments Monday, Nov. 11. Please check EMU Today for details. More campaign details will be provided by your departmental representative as the campaign progresses.

# Giving benefits EMU programs and students

Personal and corporate gifts in fiscal year 2001-02 will improve educational opportunities in several areas at Eastern Michigan University.

The estate of **Emil Weddige**, internationally noted lithographer, provided substantial scholarship support for art and music students at EMU.

A \$210,000 grant from **The Sallie Mae Fund** — the philanthropic arm of USA Education, Inc., — will enhance EMU's merit-based Presidential Scholarship Competition and Program, which helps attract top academic candidates to EMU.

A generous gift of stock from **Phil J. Jenkins** will assist the College of Education with community-based, off-campus programming.

A collaborative effort among three EMU departments has helped the University secure a large parcel of land near Traverse City.

Upon her death, **Jean Noble Parsons'** will stated that her land be given to a Michigan university that could best carry forward her ideals.

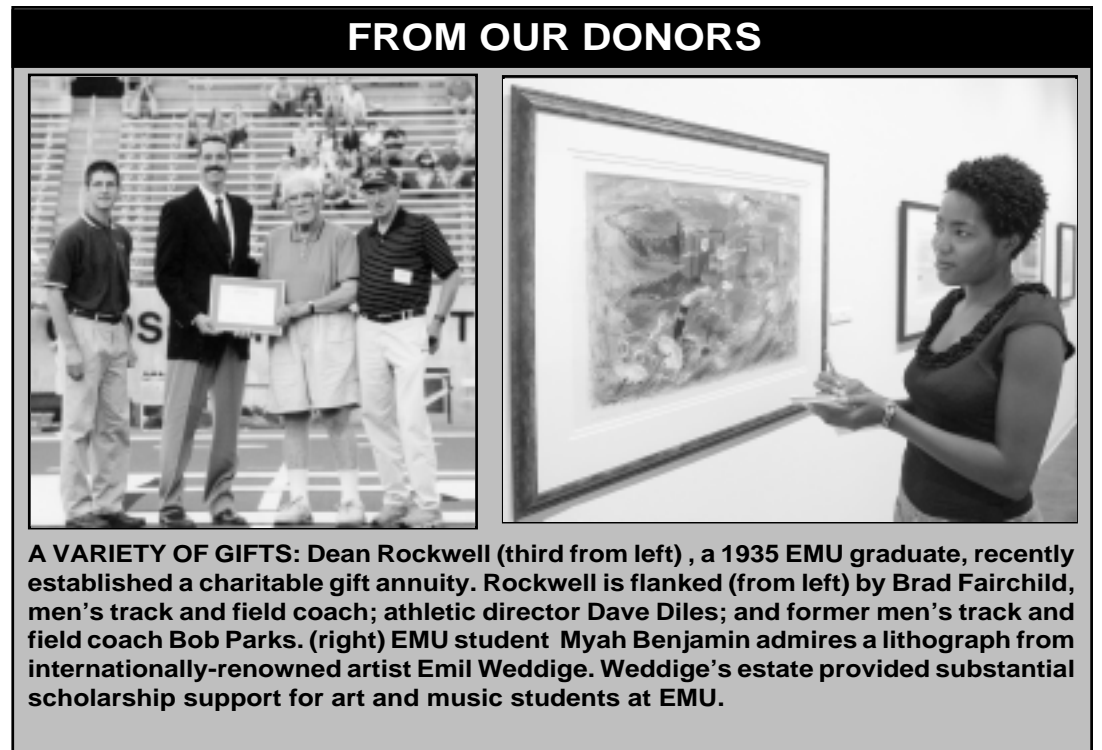
**Dean Rockwell**, a 1935 graduate, recently established a charitable gift annuity that will pay him income for life, then benefit the men's and women's track programs.

Gifts-in-kind from the **U.S. Department of Defense** to the EMU Army ROTC program once again demonstrate the government's commitment to provide the best available equipment to complement first-rate facilities provided by the University.

EMU received a \$75,000 grant from the **SBC Foundation** (the charitable giving arm of SBC Ameritech) that will initiate the New Teacher Resource Network, a partnership to improve the quality of teaching by supporting new teachers.

A generous gift from the estate of alumna **Irene Little Wallace** will enhance the endowed scholarship for undergraduate English majors that she established while she was living.

Karin Gustine made a substantial addition to the **Gustine Family Endowed Scholarship**, which will benefit students who are single parents and studying to be-

**Anthony Snoddy**, alumnus, Foundation trustee and president of Exemplar Manu-

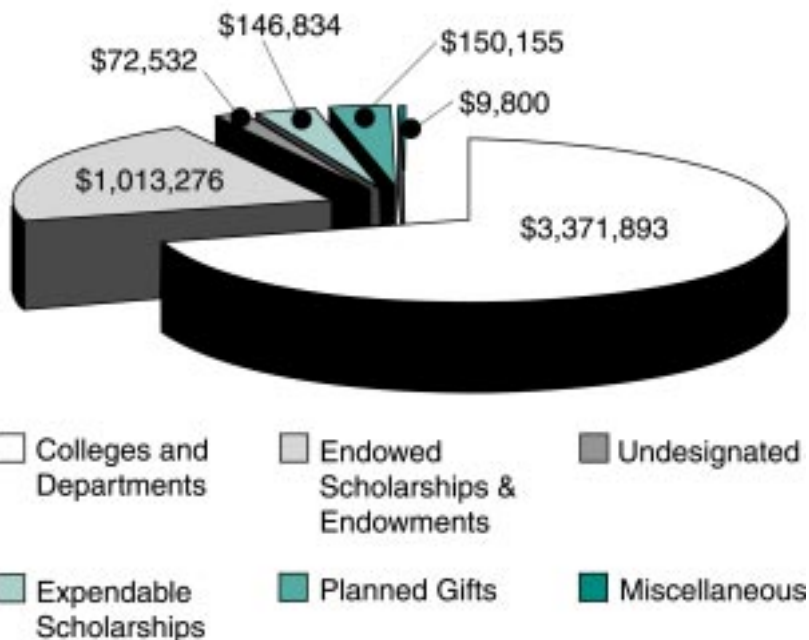
facturing Company, contributed to his scholarships for high school graduates of Ypsilanti's south side.

Area business owners **Jeanne and Ernest Merlanti** helped initiate a business ethics program in EMU's College of Business.

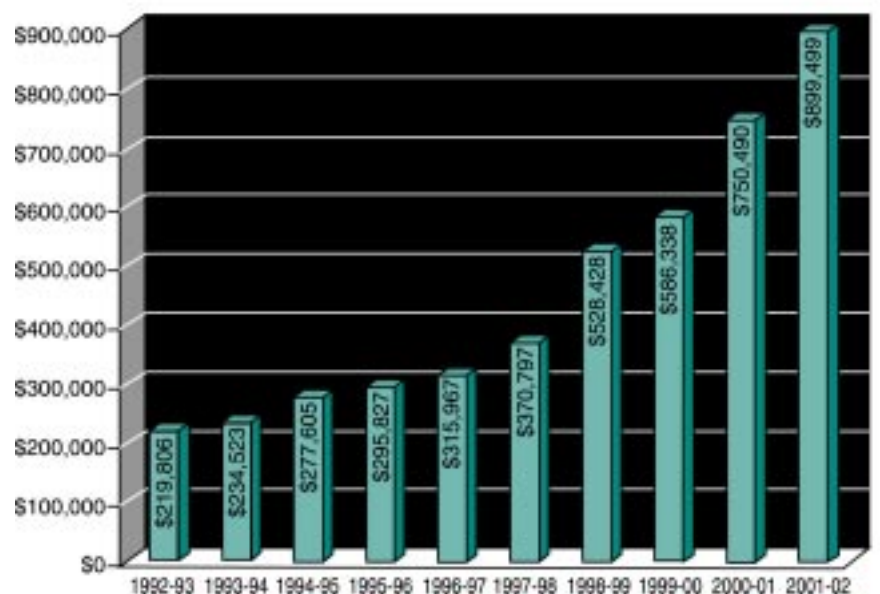
## GIVING TO EMU

### Where Gifts Were Directed in 2001-02



**SUPPORT TO COLLEGES AND DEPARTMENTS:** EMU's colleges and departments again received the largest percentage of private support. More than \$3 million, or 70.8 percent of all fund raising, went to this area. The next-largest category, at 21.3 percent, was gifts to endowed scholarships and other endowments. Expendable (current use) scholarships accounted for 3.1 percent.

**ENDOWMENTS PROVIDE INCREASING SUPPORT:** Funding from endowed scholarships and endowments provided increased support to EMU's students and programs. In fiscal year 2001-02, nearly \$900,000 was provided to the University from the endowment, a 19.9 percent increase from the prior year.
