

# LibX @ EMU Library

LibX@EMU Library is a Firefox extension that helps you discover and connect to Eastern Michigan University Library resources.

NOTE: This extension works with the Firefox browser only (versions 1.5 or higher).

**LibX Toolbar:** A search window in the toolbar allows you to search

- \* the EMU Library catalog
- \* the EMU Periodicals Locator (locate a periodical in the library's digital and shelf holdings)
- \* Google Scholar.

**Search by:** Keyword, Title, Journal Title, Author, Subject, ISBN/ISSN, or Call Number.  
(More than one field can be searched at a time)

**LIBX while browsing the web:** highlight a word or phrase on a web page and then drag-and-drop the selected text into the search box on the toolbar, or directly onto the Google Scholar button on the right end of the toolbar.

**Right-click context menu:** Highlight text on a web page and click the right mouse button to bring up a context menu that includes a number of search choices.

**Support for embedded cues:** LibX places an icon in pages from a number of web sites, including book pages at Amazon, Barnes & Noble, Alibris, and Powell's Books, as well as Google, Yahoo!, the NY Times Book Review, and other sites.

**Autolinks:** The LibX toolbar recognizes ISSNs, ISBNs, PubMed IDs and DOIs and turns them into autolinks that you may use to search for specific books or journals.

**Off-campus access to EMU subscriptions:** While off-campus, should you happen upon a web site where documents are available only to subscribers, use the right-click context menu to determine if the EMU Library paid for access to at least some of the documents on the site; LibX will enable you to enter your My.Emich identification so you can access the subscription content without leaving the web site.
