Who is eligible?

Faculty, staff, students and other individuals and groups with a university affiliation may use this service. Groups must provide a live-in coordinator and if minors are brought each group is expected to have an adult chaperone to participant ratio of 15:1.

Description

Pittman Hall Guest Housing is a low cost on-campus housing option. Each room has a twin bed, desk, dresser and wardrobe closet. Guests are issued a room key and a key card for the outside door (if they do not possess a valid Eagle ID card). There is cable TV service but no television is provided. Linen is provided (pillow, sheets, pillow case, bath towel, hand towel and blanket). Depending upon availability guests may be asked to share a bathroom adjoining their room.

The exterior door is locked 24 hours a day, seven days a week. Pittman Hall is a non-smoking facility and alcohol use is forbidden as well. Guests are required to following the rules set forth in the Guide to Campus Living which can be found at

Depending upon building occupancy there may be limited desk hours but guests have access to the Hill Hall desk from 10 a.m. – 10 p.m.
