Pre-requisite courses

The following courses are pre-requisite courses needed for the professional phase of the Dietetics Program at EMU. All courses must be completed with a grade of “C” or better on or before September 1 of the year you will begin the program. An official transcript must be posted with EMU on or before this date.
