Course selection for second-semester students

Generally, you continue in sequence courses:

MUSC 102 Music Theory II
MUSC 128 Music Literature II
MUSC 129 Aural Skills II

You must enroll in the same “section” of MUSC 102 and MUSC 129, e.g. if you take MUSC 102 at 10 AM Mon/Wed/Fri, you must take MUSC 129 at 10 AM Tues/Thurs.

MUSC 252 Functional Piano II

Applied music: Registration by Music Office staff—you must fill out the applied music registration form, have your professor sign it, and turn it in to the Music Office.

Ensemble: may require audition—see ensemble director

You enroll in General Education courses on your own (online using your my.emich account)

If you are a MEDI (music education instrumental) or MEDV (music education vocal) major, you may begin taking secondary instrument classes.

MUTR (music therapy) majors should meet with the music therapy advisor (Prof. McGuire)

MPRF (music performance) majors should consult with their applied music professor.

DANC majors should consult with the Dance faculty advisor.
