

BARRY MANILOW SCHOLARSHIP AWARD
(awarded for 2012 – 2013)

The Department of Music and Dance will present the *Barry Manilow Scholarship Award* (approximately \$900.00) to an outstanding performer who will be a full-time student during both the Fall and Winter semesters in which they will hold the award. Applicants **must be admitted** to an undergraduate degree program in the Department of Music and Dance or CTA. Previous winners and students on Conditional Admission, Alternative Admission or Special Student status are ineligible to apply. **This award may be received in addition to other major university or department scholarships.**

The Scholarship will be awarded on the basis of the criteria given below:

1. Performance Competency & Presentation. (The degree of difficulty of the selection will also be taken into consideration.)
2. GPA (minimum of 3.0).
3. Leadership within the Department of Music or CTA.
4. Initiative.

Competition

Friday, January 27, 2012, Alexander Recital Hall, 3 p.m.

Performance time is limited to ten (10) minutes. **Please note** that only one performer shall be considered as the entrant and clearly designated as such on the application. The audition performance is open to the public.

Application

To be considered for this award, the attached application must be submitted to julie.stone@cmich.edu with the heading *Manilow scholarship application form* or hard copy to Julie Stone through the Music and Dance office.

Procedure

Accepted applicants should sign-up for a performance time. A sign-up sheet will be posted on the music locker area bulletin board by Monday, January 23, 2012. Time will be made available, through the Department of Music and Dance office, for accepted applicants to practice in Alexander Recital Hall. Auditions will be heard by representative judges from Department of Music and Dance faculty and CTA. Scholarship recipient recommendations will be forwarded to Barry Manilow for the final award decision. Results of the selection process will be announced as soon as possible.
