

Ad Copy for Tenure-track Faculty Position in Educational Leadership

The College of Education at Grand Valley State University invites applications for a full-time, tenure-track, Assistant Professor position in the Educational Leadership program beginning Fall 2012. Qualifications for the position include administrative experience in K-12 schools and a Ph.D. or Ed.D. in Educational Leadership or closely related field. ABD candidates will be considered if completed by July 2012. Must demonstrate a capacity to teach using multiple modes of instruction, including online, hybrid, web-enhanced, and face-to-face instruction. Must be willing to travel to distant sites and deliver courses on weekends or other non-traditional times.

Primary responsibilities include: teaching graduate courses in the field of Educational Leadership, advising and directing students in the Educational Leadership Master's program, maintaining a scholarly research agenda through peer-reviewed publications and presentations, participating in shared governance at the departmental, college and university levels, and providing service, expertise, and leadership to the profession and community.
