

ADMISSION TO THE RN/BSN COMPLETION OPTION

Interested nurses should apply to both Eastern Michigan University and to the School of Nursing. Applicants must meet the following admission requirements.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS FOR EASTERN MICHIGAN UNIVERSITY

- Application to Eastern Michigan University. Consult with the [EMU Office of Admissions](#) regarding application forms, procedures, requirements, and deadlines. Admission to the university takes an average of 2-3 weeks.
- An official transcript from each educational institution you have attended must be submitted for the EMU admission application to be processed.
- Applicants must submit a TOEFL or MELAB that meets EMU requirements if English is a second language.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS FOR THE RN/BSN COMPLETION OPTION

- A student identification number from Eastern Michigan University.
- Application to the RN/BSN completion option located on the EMU School of Nursing website.
- Current unrestricted license to practice as a registered nurse.
- A 2.5 cumulative college G.P.A. (4.0 scale).
- Successful completion of a college level course in English composition with a minimum course grade of 3.0 (4.0 scale) or higher prior to entry into the option.
- Designation on application of first and second choices for site preference for coursework.
- Priority for admission into the RN/BSN option will be given to those applicants who have completed general education requirements at EMU or are MACRAO satisfied.

Applicants who hold a registered nurse license, a bachelor's degree in another discipline, **AND** are seeking a bachelor's degree in nursing **MUST MEET** with the [EMU second-degree adviser](#) in addition to the above requirements (734-487-7121).
