

Master of Science in Nursing (MSN) Admission Process

Procedure for Application to the Nursing Graduate Programs:

1. Submit a Application for Graduate Admission with a \$30 application fee
2. Have an Official transcript submitted for each school attended
3. Indicate your program of study:
NU99 Master of Science in Nursing – Adult Health
NU98 Graduate Certificate: Teaching in Health Care Systems
NU97 Post Masters Advanced Graduate Certificate Adult Nurse Practitioner
If you are not certain of the program of study or have insufficient time to complete the admission process, you can list Self-Improvement.
4. Submit additional information to fulfill admission requirements:
 - Verification of a current professional nursing license in Michigan
 - Sample of your writing (approximately 5 pages of a paper, document developed for your work setting or a personal biography).
 - Narrative statement of 1-2 pages of your personal goals for graduate study
 - Verification of a basic statistics course
 - Verification of a basic health assessment course
 - Three professional references
 - Students for whom English is a second language, must comply with graduate student English proficiency requirements.
