

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS FOR EASTERN MICHIGAN UNIVERSITY

- Application to Eastern Michigan University. Consult with the [EMU Office of Admissions](#) regarding application forms, procedures, requirements, and deadlines. Admission to the university takes an average of 2-3 weeks.
- The School of Nursing requires a transcript for all colleges/universities attended. Applicants must submit an **official** transcript for each institution attended to: **Eastern Michigan University, Office of Admissions, 401 Pierce Hall**. It is not necessary to submit transcripts for courses taken at Eastern Michigan University.
- Applicants must submit a TOEFL or MELAB that meets EMU requirements if English is a second language.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS FOR THE RN/BSN COMPLETION OPTION:

- A Student Identification Number from Eastern Michigan University.
- [Application to the RN/BSN Completion Option](#).
- Current unrestricted license to practice as a registered nurse.
- A 2.5 cumulative college G.P.A. (on a 4.0 scale).
- Successful completion of a college level course in English composition with a minimum course grade of 3.0 (4.0 scale) or higher prior to entry into the program.
- Designation on application of first and second choice for site preference for coursework.
- Priority for admission into the RN/BSN option will be given to those applicants who have completed general education requirements at EMU or are MACRAO satisfied.

It is the applicant's responsibility to submit copies of academic records and other requested documents by October 1st for winter semester admission. Applicants are responsible for establishing that courses taken are equivalent to the required courses.
