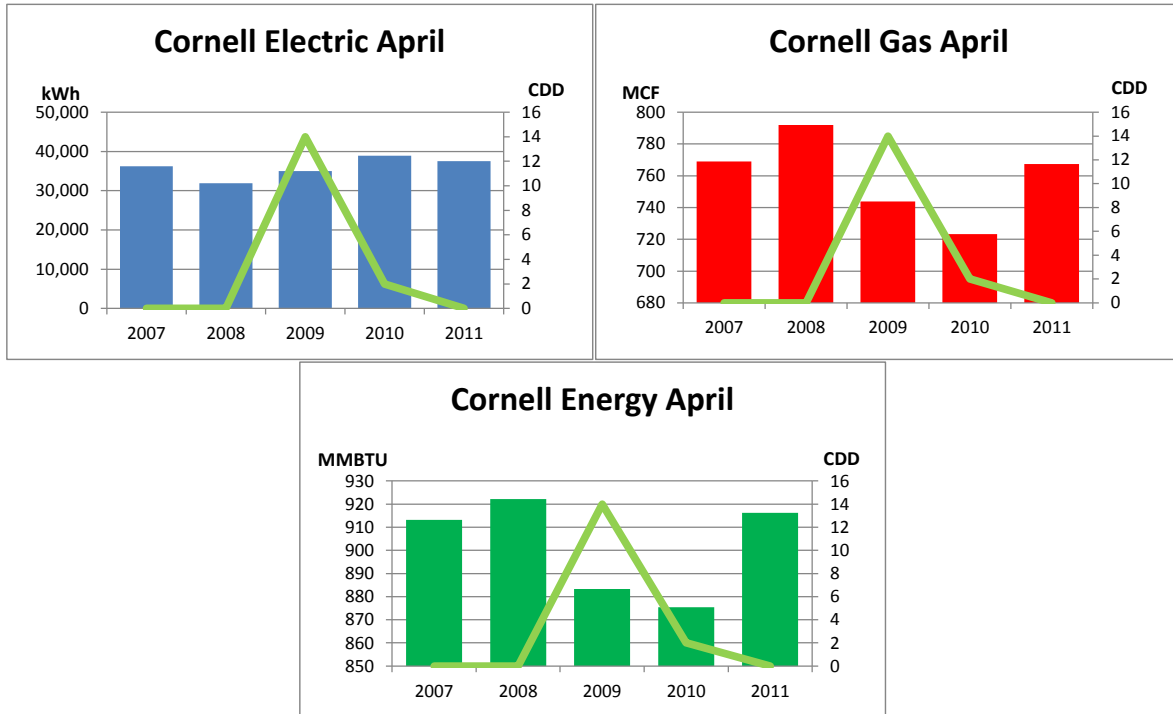


Monthly Energy Report

Cornell
April, 2011



This month, Cornell used 37,556 kWh of electricity and 767 MCF of gas, for a total of 916 MMBTU of energy use. This is a 5% increase in total energy use from this month last year and a 3% increase from the three-year average. Electricity costs for this month were \$2,967 and gas costs were \$4,911 for a total cost of \$7,878.



In the last 12 months, Cornell has used 458,322 kWh of electricity and 7,684 MCF of gas, for a total of 9,455 MMBTU of energy use. This is a 11% increase in total energy use from the previous 12 months. Electricity costs for this year were \$36,207 and gas costs were \$49,175 for a total cost of \$85,382.
