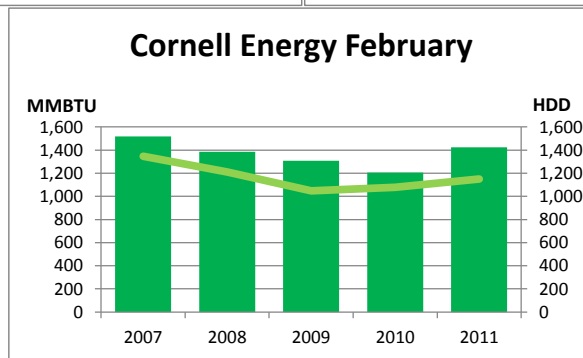
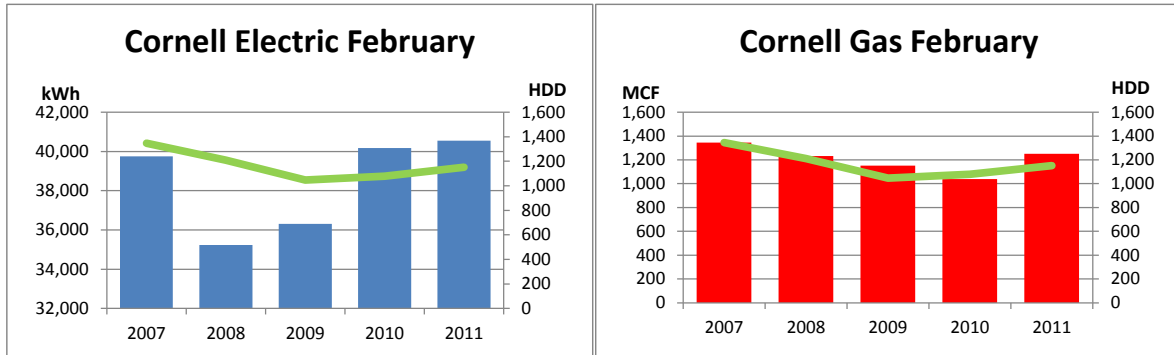


# Monthly Energy Report

Cornell

February, 2011

This month, Cornell used 40,553 kWh of electricity and 1,251 MCF of gas, for a total of 1,423 MMBTU of energy use. This is a 18% increase in total energy use from this month last year and a 10% increase from the three-year average. Electricity costs for this month were \$3,204 and gas costs were \$8,008 for a total cost of \$11,212.



In the last 12 months, Cornell has used 459,520 kWh of electricity and 7,523 MCF of gas, for a total of 9,294 MMBTU of energy use. This is a 8% increase in total energy use from the previous 12 months. Electricity costs for this year were \$36,302 and gas costs were \$48,145 for a total cost of \$84,447.
