

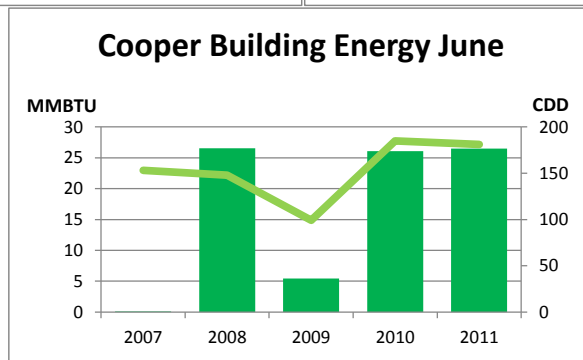
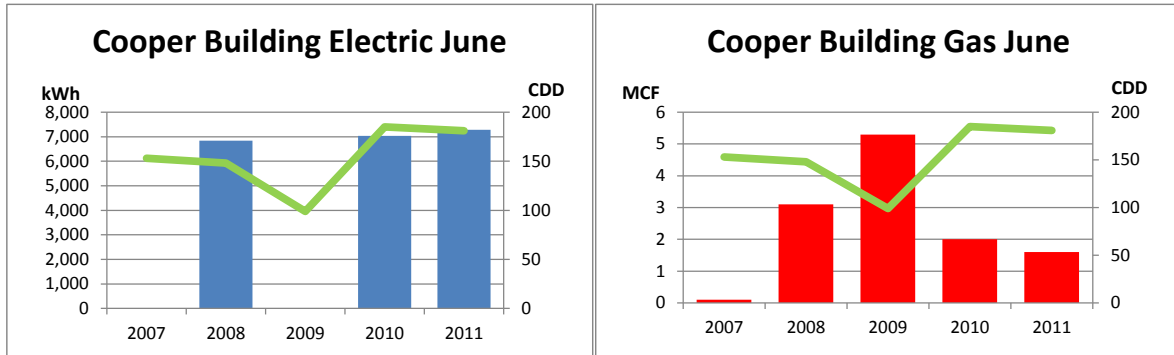
# Monthly Energy Report

Cooper Building

June, 2011



This month, Cooper Building used 7,280 kWh of electricity and 2 MCF of gas, for a total of 26 MMBTU of energy use. This is a 2% increase in total energy use from this month last year and a 37% increase from the three-year average. Electricity costs for this month were \$575 and gas costs were \$10 for a total cost of \$585.



In the last 12 months, Cooper Building has used 90,400 kWh of electricity and 409 MCF of gas, for a total of 728 MMBTU of energy use. This is a 15% increase in total energy use from the previous 12 months. Electricity costs for this year were \$7,142 and gas costs were \$2,614 for a total cost of \$9,756.
