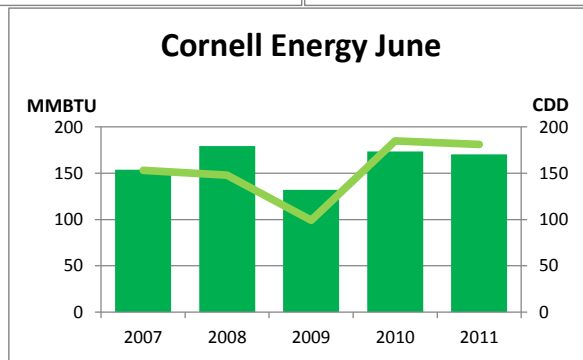
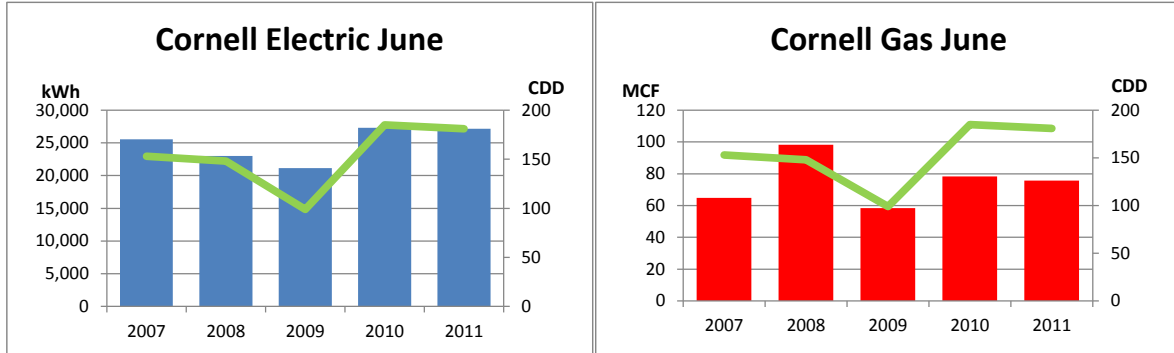


Monthly Energy Report

Cornell
June, 2011



This month, Cornell used 27,161 kWh of electricity and 76 MCF of gas, for a total of 170 MMBTU of energy use. This is a 2% decrease in total energy use from this month last year and a 5% increase from the three-year average. Electricity costs for this month were \$2,146 and gas costs were \$484 for a total cost of \$2,630.



In the last 12 months, Cornell has used 460,249 kWh of electricity and 7,890 MCF of gas, for a total of 9,673 MMBTU of energy use. This is a 12% increase in total energy use from the previous 12 months. Electricity costs for this year were \$36,360 and gas costs were \$50,494 for a total cost of \$86,854.
