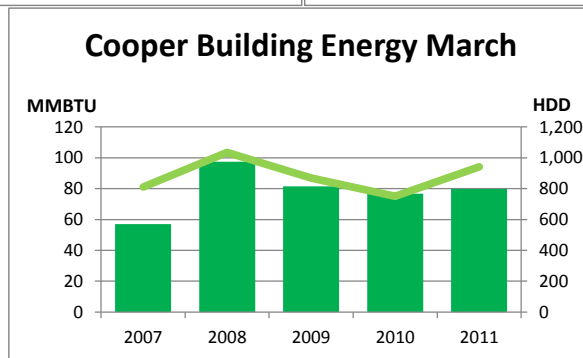
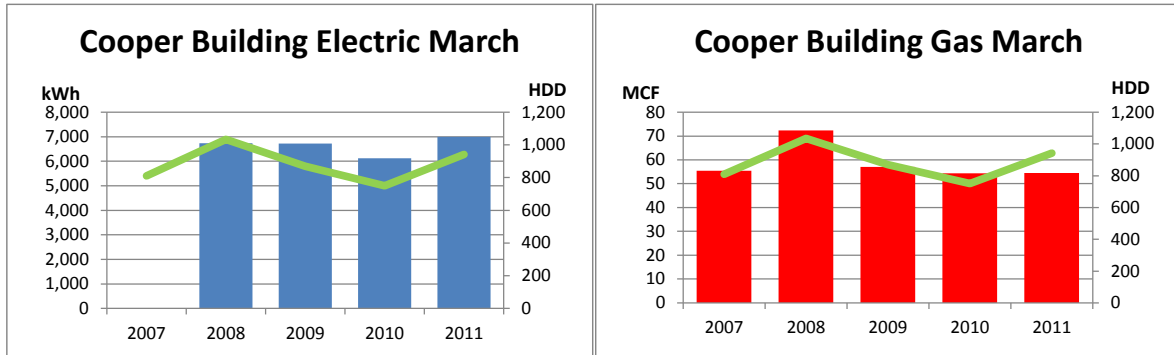


# Monthly Energy Report

## Cooper Building

March, 2011

This month, Cooper Building used 7,000 kWh of electricity and 55 MCF of gas, for a total of 80 MMBTU of energy use. This is a 4% increase in total energy use from this month last year and a 6% decrease from the three-year average. Electricity costs for this month were \$553 and gas costs were \$349 for a total cost of \$902.



In the last 12 months, Cooper Building has used 87,960 kWh of electricity and 393 MCF of gas, for a total of 704 MMBTU of energy use. This is a 14% increase in total energy use from the previous 12 months.

Electricity costs for this year were \$6,949 and gas costs were \$2,514 for a total cost of \$9,463.
